# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### Who should apply?

Educators with at least one year of classroom teaching experience and are currently teaching or will be teaching US history or social studies (grades 6-12), curriculum specialists, and/or similar roles in a formal education setting.

#### How many teachers will participate in the program?

20 teachers will be selected.

## When are applications due?

Applications will be accepted from December 1, 2025 – January 30, 2026.

#### Is there a cost?

No. All teachers will receive a travel and meal stipend, and non-local teachers will be housed at the Hilton Washington, DC National Mall.

#### When will participants be notified if accepted?

All applicants will be notified by April 1, 2026, of their status.

#### How many credits are included?

27 professional development hours will be earned upon completion of this program.

#### What is the selection process?

SPY's Education Department will review all applications and score them using a predetermined rubric. To create a diverse group of educators for this institute, the following criteria will be taken into consideration: types of school, years of teaching, location, student body, and grade level taught.

# Where will non-local teachers stay?

Housing for non-local teachers will be provided by SPY at the Hilton Washington, DC National Mall from Sunday, June 28, 2026 – Thursday, July 2, 2026.
