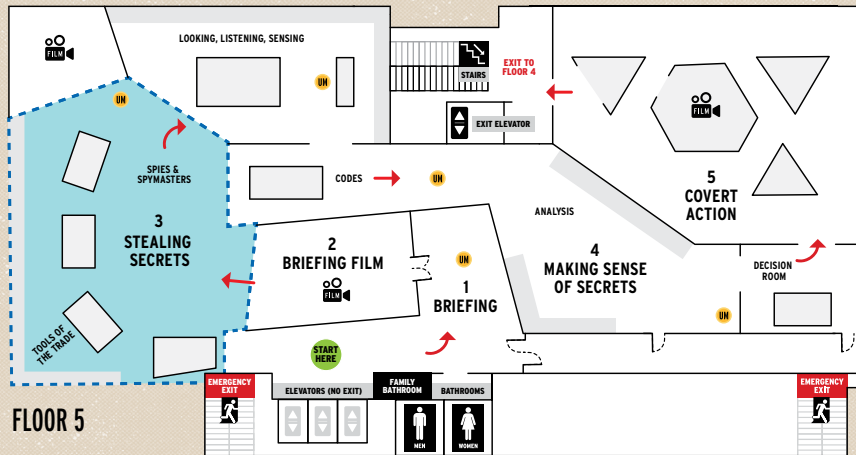

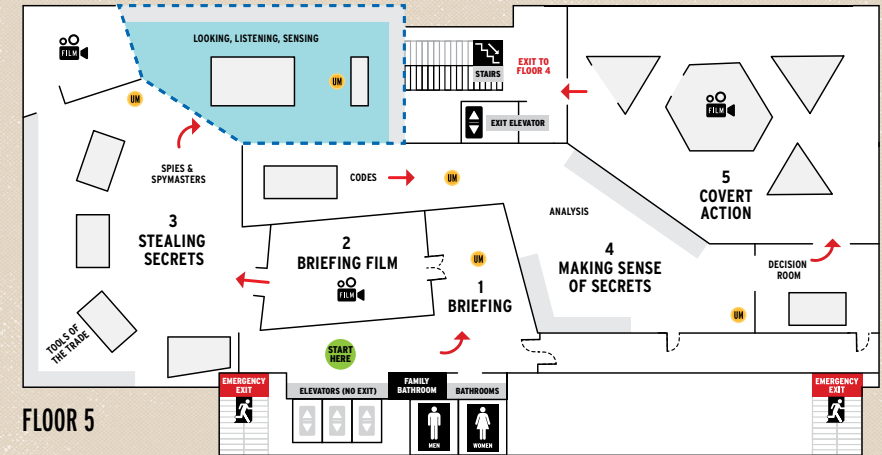


SPIES AND SPYMASTERS

- 1 This **object** was hidden in a suitcase and used by WWII spy Virginia Hall to send secret messages back to the Allies.

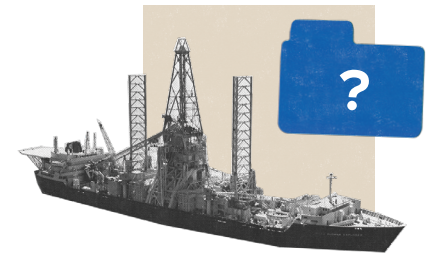


- 2 This **person** snuck into British camps during the American Revolution to collect intelligence.

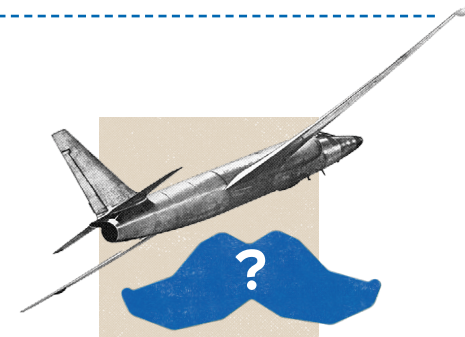


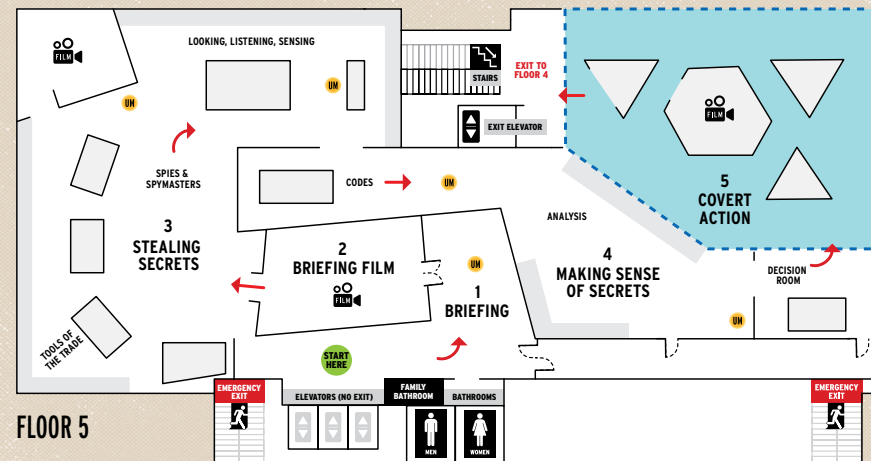
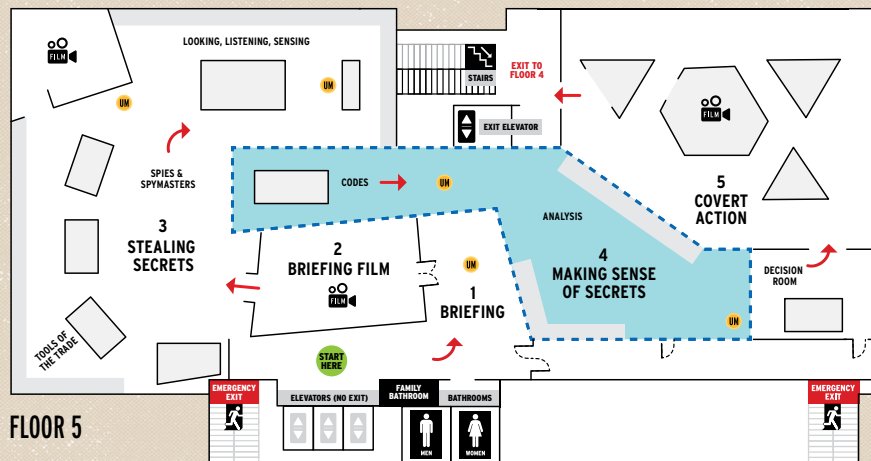
LOOKING, LISTENING, SENSING

- 5 This **person** was one of the original 29 Navajo code talkers who created an unbreakable code for the US military.



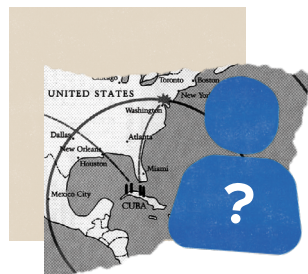
COVERT ACTION

ANALYSIS

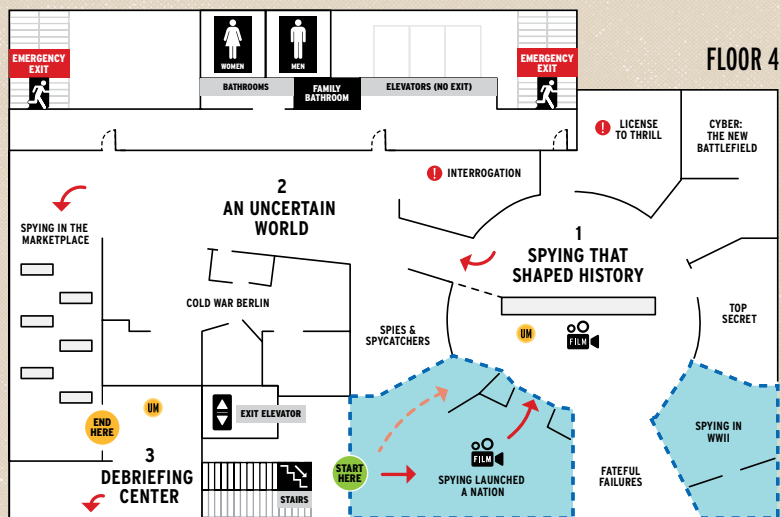
- 6 This **person** had to decide how to respond after the United States discovered nuclear missiles in Cuba in 1962.

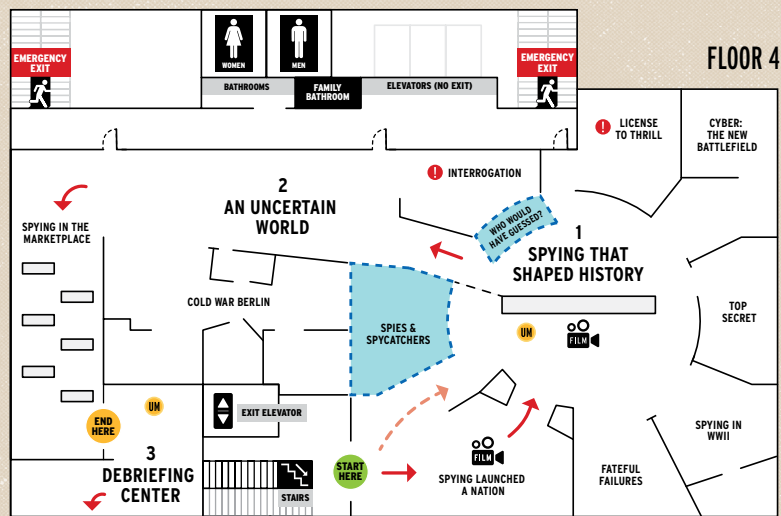
- 9 This **person** is considered the "founding father" of the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA).

- 11 This **operation** was one of the first cyberattacks on the United States, stealing secret information from government computers in the 1990s.



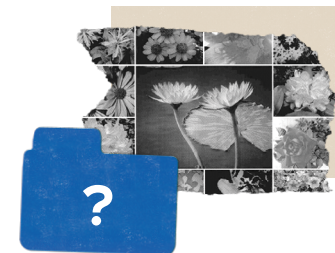


WHO WOULD HAVE GUESSED

- 12 During the Civil War, this **person** ran a spy ring for the Union in Richmond, Virginia.

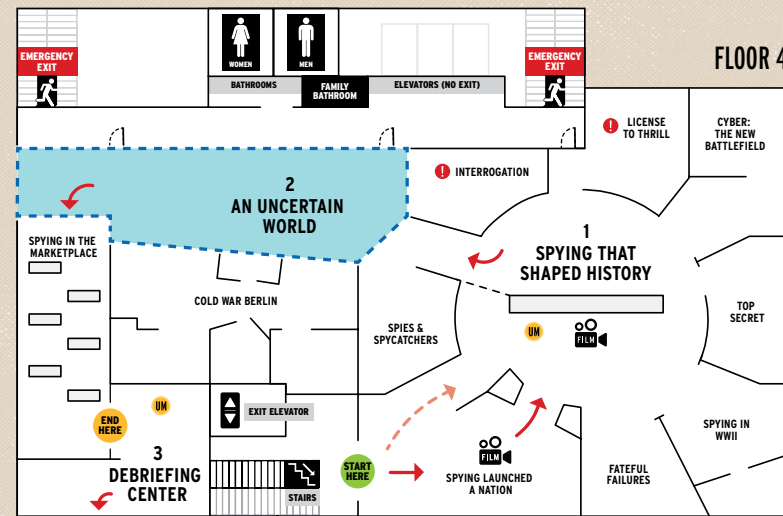


- 14 During this **operation**, the FBI followed 10 Russian spies as they operated undercover in the United States.
